

GGSF Woolly Creations- Sheep Craft



Introduction:

Welcome to the woolly world of sheep! In this engaging craft activity, kindergarteners will have the opportunity to create their very own fluffy sheep to display proudly at the fair. These woolly companions are sure to steal the spotlight!

Materials that you will need:

- Paper Plate
- Construction Paper
- Cotton Balls
- Googly Eyes
- Glue
- White Crayon
- Scissors



GGSF Woolly Creations– Directions

Step One:

Glue cotton balls to the paper plate.

Step Two:

Cut out two small oval shapes for the ears and an oval shape from the construction paper for the face.

Step Three:

Cut out (2) ovals or half circles from the construction paper for the arms.

Step Four:

Cut out (2) longer ovals or half circles from the construction paper for the legs.

Step Five:

Glue the googly eyes onto the face.

Step Six:

Use the white crayon to draw a small smile on the face.

Step Seven:

Glue the arms and legs to the body.

Step Eight:

Attach a name tag to the sheep listing– the child's name and teacher's name

Step Nine:

Now, your sheep is ready to come to the fair!
