Introduction:

Materials that you will need:

- White Foam Cup
- Black and Pink Construction Paper
- Googly Eyes
- Glue
- Scissors



GGSF Moo-velous Creations- Directions

Step One:

Cut out the shapes from the black construction paper for the spots.

Step Two:

Glue the spots on the cup.

Step Three:

Cut out a white circle for the cow's head and two white ovals for the ears.

Step Four:

Cut out a pink circle for the cow's noes/mouth area.

Step Five:

Cut out two black ovals for the cow's hair.

Step Six:

Draw two black dots for the cow's nostrils.

Step Seven:

Glue the cow's snout, hair, and eyes to the cow's face.

Step Eight:

Draw a smile on the cow's face.

Step Nine:

Attach a name tag to the cow listing- the child's name and teacher's name.

Step Ten:

Now, your cow is ready to come to the fair!
