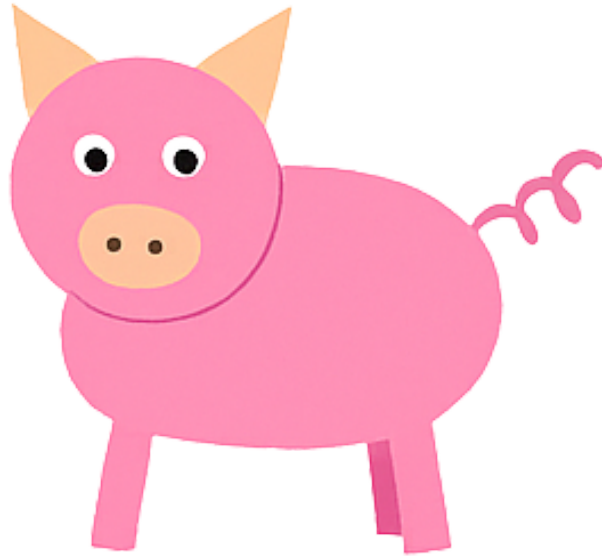




GGSF Oink-tastic Creations- Pig Craft



Introduction:

Welcome, first grade artists, to a fantastic crafting adventure where we turn something old into something new and adorable! With a dash of creativity and a sprinkle of imagination, we'll make these pigs shine at the fair. Let's roll up our sleeves and dive into this exciting project!

Materials that you will need:

- Googly Eyes
- Pipe Cleaner
- Pink and Tan Construction Paper
- Glue/Tape
- Scissors
- Pink Marker



GGSF Oink-tastic Creations- Directions

Step One:

Cut 2 small ovals or circles from the pink construction paper. Make one oval bigger than the other.

Step Two:

Cut out (2) triangle for the pink and tan construction paper. Make the tan triangles smaller than the pink ones.

Step Three:

Cut out a small oval from the tan paper for the pig's snout and draw two black dots for it's nose.

Step Four:

Glue the two pink ovals together to make the body.

Step Five:

Glue the googly eyes and snout to the pig's face.

Step Six:

Tape the pipe cleaner to the back of pig's body for the tail.

Step Seven:

Color the two clothespin with the pink marker.

Step Eight:

Clip the clothes pin to the pig's body.

Step Nine:

Attach a name tag to the pig listing- the child's name and teacher's name.

Step Ten:

Now, your pig is ready to come to the fair!
